After working in various institutions of the Turkish Navy for four years, he completed his Internal Diseases Specialization between 1972-1976 and worked at Çanakkale and Kasımpaşa Naval Hospitals. In 1978, he took a Public Health Course at Norway Oslo University. He worked in the Endocrinology and Metabolism Clinic at Edinburgh Western General Hospital for one year in 1986.
